WEEK OF ROCKETS - BLAST-OFF!



DRONE MAPPING - GET LAUNCHED

Students will learn the latest cutting edge technology for small Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) and how to safely operate them, as a component of this science, technology and aviation-related camp! Our FAA certified instructor will walk you through the steps of navigation and the introduction of mapping using a DJI Phantom 3 Drone and cloud based computing software. Get ready to video, photograph and map out our town, producing high resolution imagery as it has never been seen before. Plus it is just a whole lot of fun to fly drones.
